Daily Bible Study and Prayers for the week of February 3, 2025

(Suggestion: put your answers into your computer or in a notebook, to allow God to speak to you fully through the wonder of the writing process.

Monday - Read Hebrews 6:4-8 (Also Hebrews 10:26-31 and 2Peter 2:20-21)

Question – The writer of Hebrews has been trying for six chapters to encourage his Christian readers not to backslide or "fall away" from the faith but, instead, to grow in the Christian faith. One way that he attempted this was by reminding them that, "It is impossible" for a backslidden Christian "to be brought back to repentance". The question for today is, "brought back to repentance" by whom?

Prayer For Today – Pray for the Holy Spirit to convict any backslidden former Christians whom you may know to come back to a saving faith in Christ and a life of going on to perfection/maturity (6:1).

Tuesday - Read Hebrews 6:9-12

Question – What are the "things that accompany salvation" (v. 9)? Do these "things" save us from our sins?

Prayer For Today – Pray that you would not be a "lazy" (v. 12) Christian.

Wednesday - Read Hebrews 6:13-20

Question – What did the high priest do "behind the curtain" of the temple? Prayer For Today – Pray by putting an image of Jesus on the cross in your mind.

Thursday - Read Hebrews 7:1-10

Question – Are you returning a "tenth" (verses 4, 5, 6, 8, 9) of your income back to God? Prayer For Today – Pray for faith to begin, or to keep, tithing.

Friday - Read Hebrews 7:11-25

Question – According to these verses, why could Jesus' sacrifice atone for our sins but the sacrifices of the Temple priests could not? What was/is different about Jesus?

Prayer For Today – Pray for the Jewish people today to believe in Jesus.

Saturday - Read Hebrews 7:26-28

Question – What do these verses show us is the biggest difference between Jesus and the high priests of Old Testament times?

Prayer For Today – Pray by thanking Jesus for taking away your sins.

Sunday - Read Hebrews 8:1-13

Question – What makes the "new" covenant of Jesus "superior" (v. 6) to that of the OT? Prayer For Today – Pray a prayer of thanks that you live after Jesus came!
