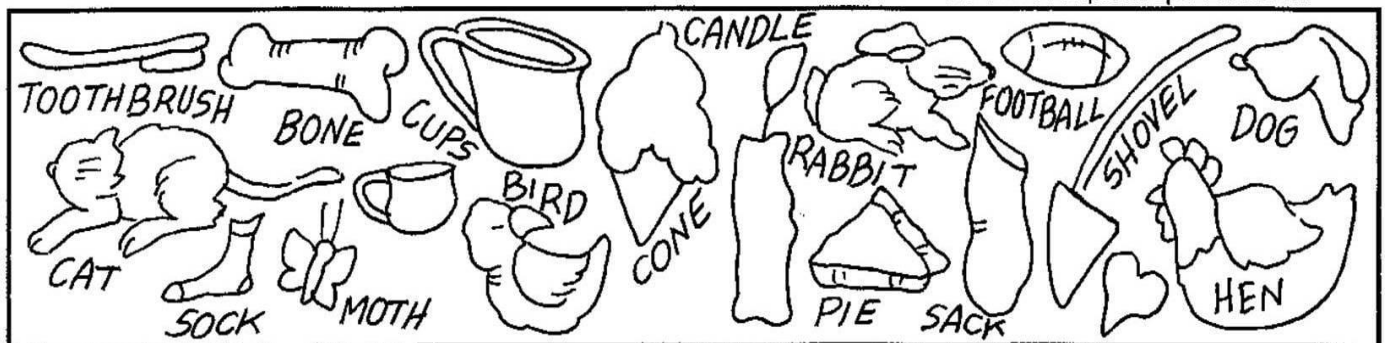
What Makes A Dad

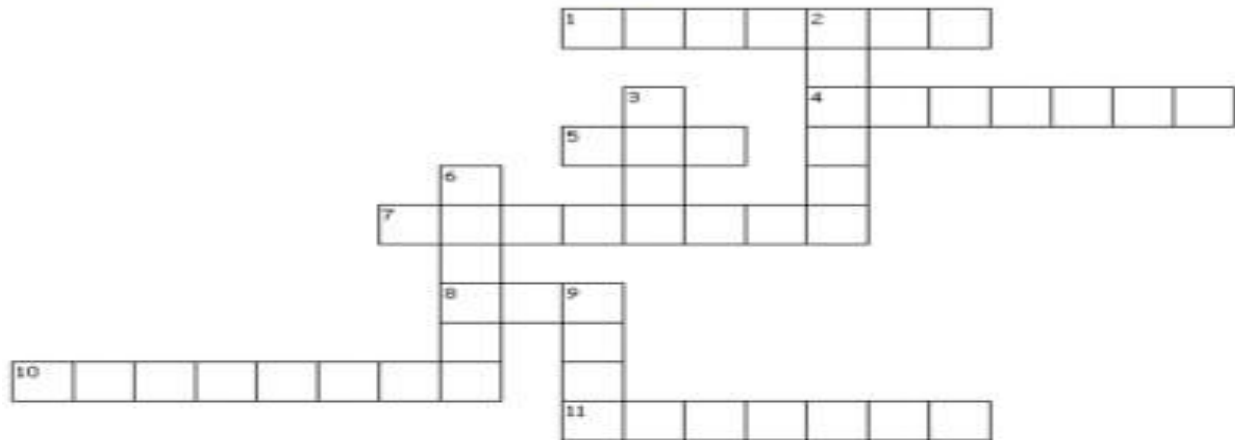
