I have a few more years of one on one, then he will drive and work and marry. Breakfast sandwiches from a drive thru. Perhaps he will remember.

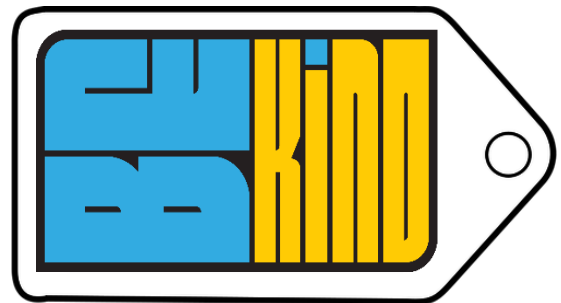

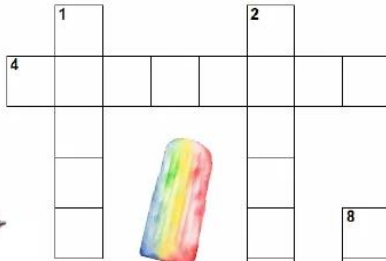

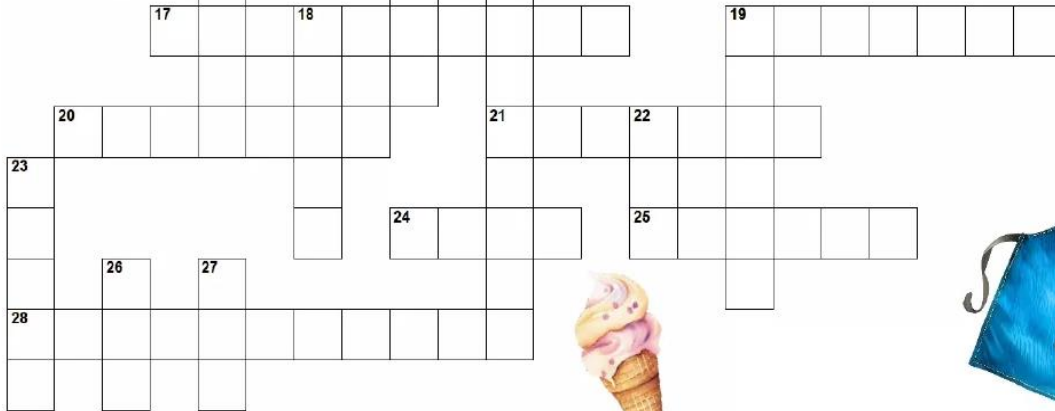
