Choir is once again starting on Wednesday, September 10th, from 7:00-8:45PM.

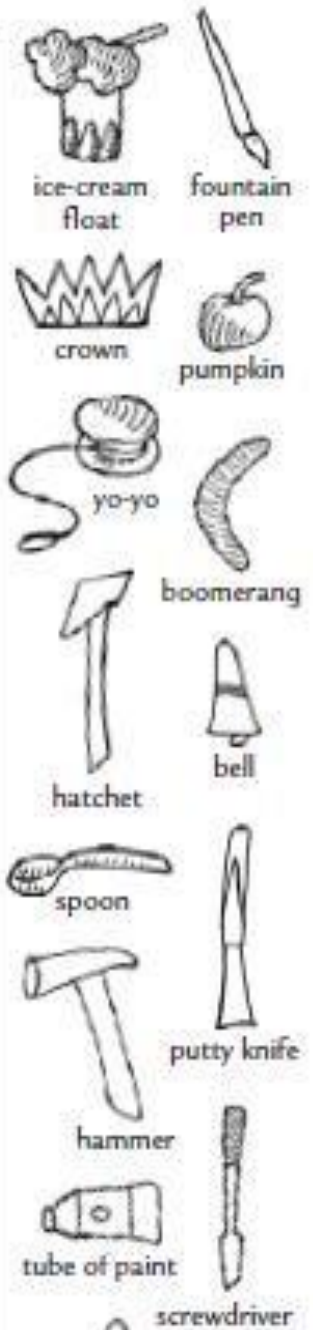

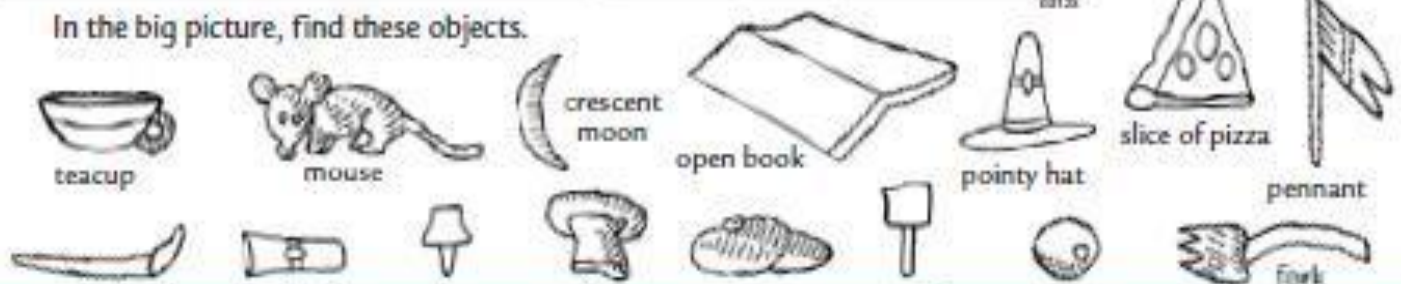
