I just saw the preview to a movie called Bambi the Reckoning. A deer with fangs chasing a family in the woods. As a kid I always loved scary movies.

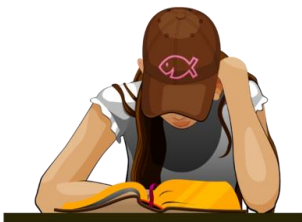
Not so much now as technology is way overboard. I still

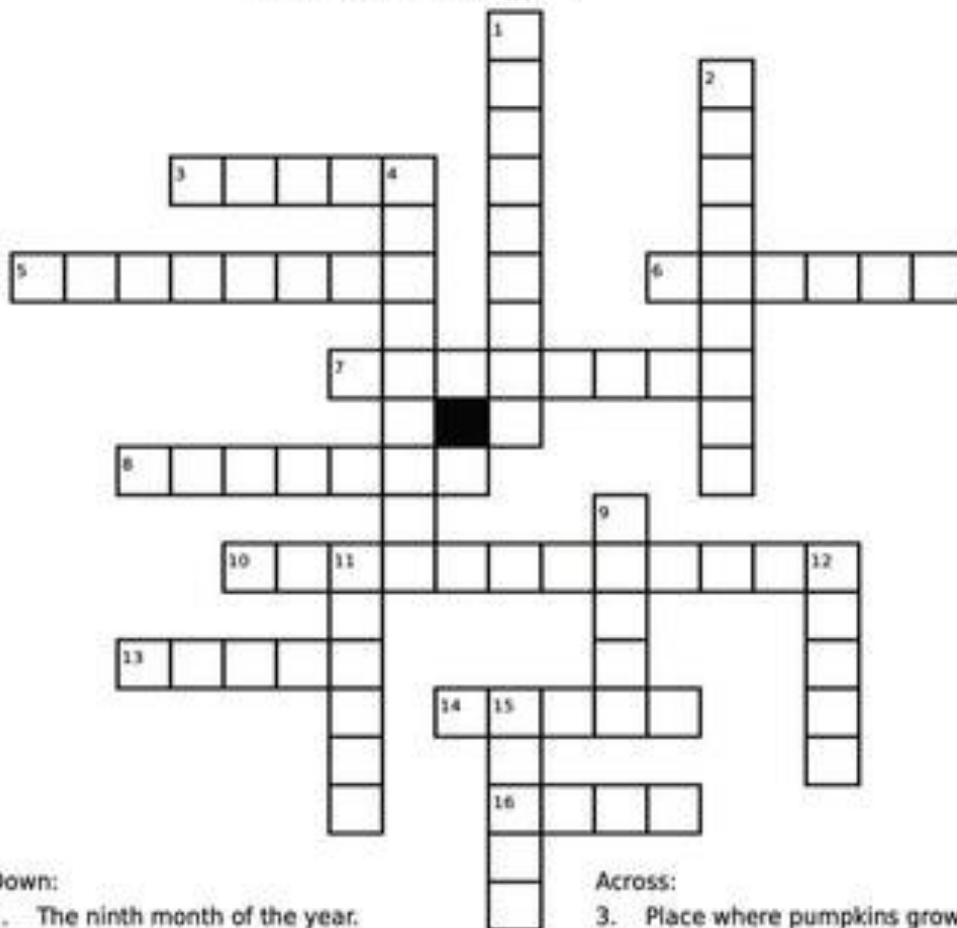
