I want to tell you about a special family that came shopping three years ago. Let's say the mom's name is Beth Jones. She was referred to us by someone in our church or from a local agency or even word of mouth. We don't know. Beth had lost her job and was searching for another but just didn't know how she was going to handle Christmas presents that year. She came shopping for her three children, purchasing about 5 items of toys and other items for each child, any clothes she could get for a dollar a piece, and possibly shoes for under \$3. It made her Christmas possible.

The following Christmas, I received a letter in the mail from Beth thanking me for the help last year. Instead of asking for more help, she was giving back a check of several hundred dollars to the ministry. She wanted to give back to the provider to help other people in need, just like she had been.

Now this is not expected at all. We are here to be the hands and feet of Jesus, helping the hurting and troubled. But knowing that we made an impact on the Jones family that year made our ministry rewarding in a way.

I encourage you to learn more about the Christmas Chest in the next few months. We will be having one last push for items in October and will be ready to get volunteers to sign up to help in December.

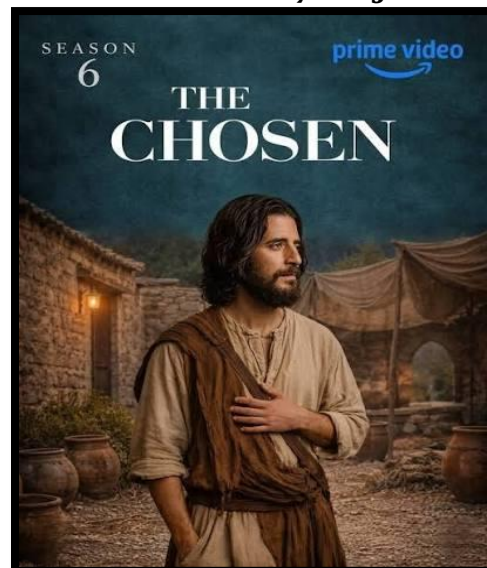

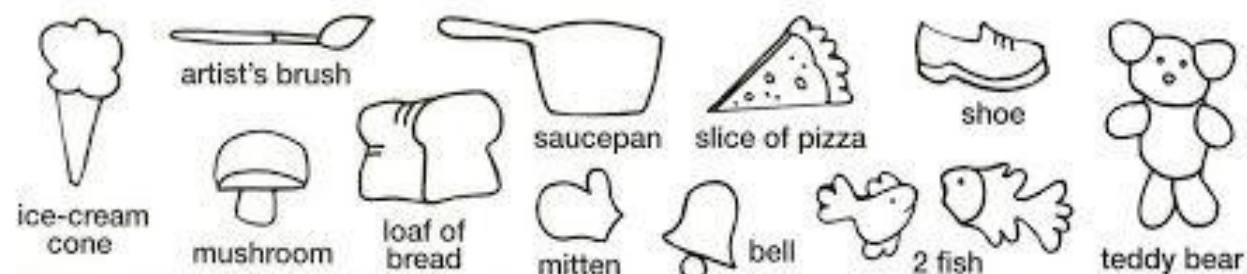

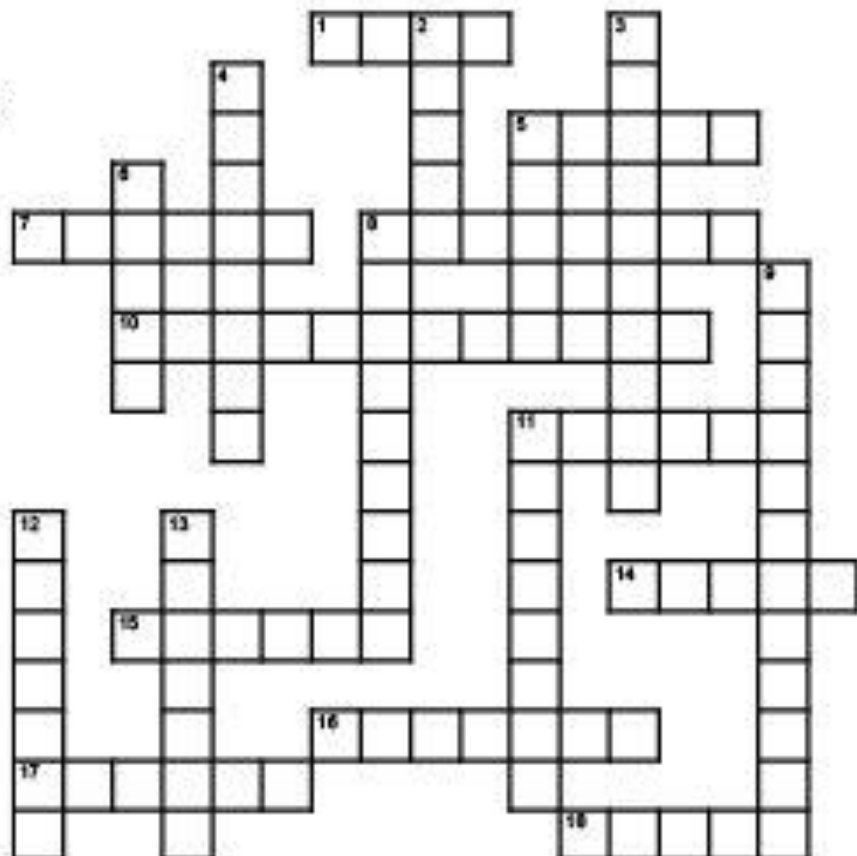
